



Step 1: Select the Launchpad from the taskbar.



Step 2: Use the search bar at the top and search for "Keychain Access".








Step 3: Select and Open Keychain Access




Step 4: Select "Login" from the top left, and then select "Certificates" from the top bar.








Step 5: Find "ECA Root CA 4" and "ECA Root CA 5". Make sure they both have the blue plus symbol to the left of the name, which implies that the certificate is trusted.







Step 6: Find "DoD Root CA 3", "DoD Root CA 4", "DoD Root CA 5", and "DoD Root CA 6". Make sure they both have the blue plus symbol to the left of the name, which implies that the certificate is trusted.



Once those files have been confirmed to be in the correct place, and marked correctly with blue check marks, you have confirmed that your Trust Chain is set up correctly.
